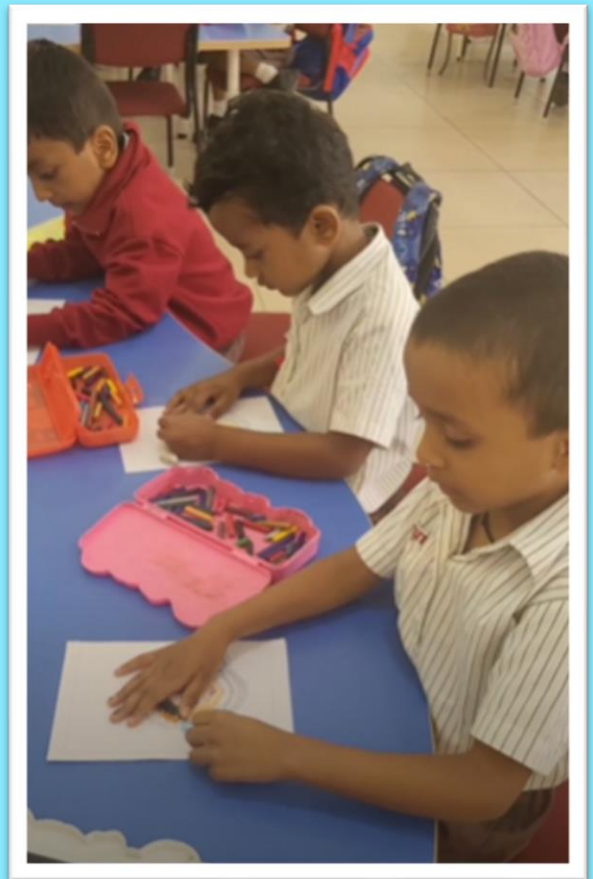




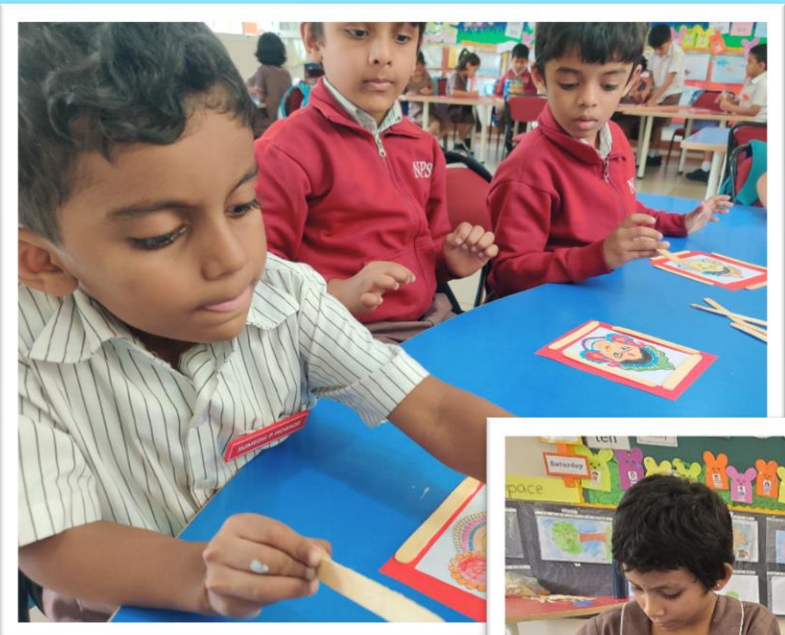
# Dasara

# Diwali





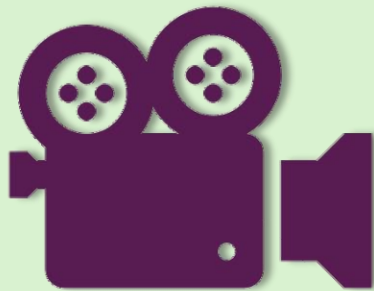

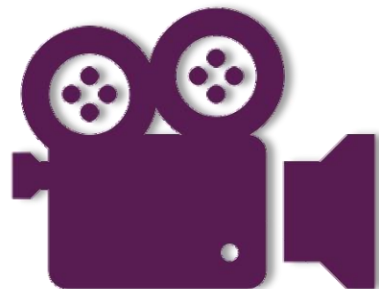


# Bagless Day

# KG 1





**The Literary Maven:** Letters of the alphabet (F, B, J, Z, W, V, X, Y, Q) and A-Z in sequence. Cursive letters (i, u, c, e, v, w, n, m, a, s, r, o, x, l, b, h), vowels, sight words, VC, CVC words, reading pictures and story, Reading Books Band 0 Lilac.

**Arithmetic Village:** Numbers 1 to 35, sorting, concepts like relationships, visual discrimination, comparison (big and small, tall and short, heavy and light, long and short, fat and thin) and months of the year (oral).



**EVS:** Magnets, Animal Life (Wild animals, Farm animals, Birds, Insects and Aquatic animals)



# **The Creative Studio:**

Dasara, Diwali, Kannada Rajyotsava, freehand drawing of insects and guided drawing of birds.



**Practise 'n' Perform:** Gross Motor Skills -Yoga, Aerobics and Games (bombing the city, bouncing and dodging ball, zig zag walk through cones, ball and bucket game, hopping, animal exercises).

**The Literary Maven:** Blending, segmenting, digraphs, sight words, long vowel sounds and its alternatives, picture comprehension, questions and answers, simple sentences, rhymes and songs, storytelling, speaking and listening activities.

**Arithmetic Village:** Skip count by 10s, comparisons, backward counting and before numbers, smaller numbers, descending order, picture addition, finger addition up to 10, addition with 0 and 1, word problems, sequencing events.

**EVS:** Seasons, sources of water, states of water, uses of water, sink and float, what dissolves in water





# The Creative Studio: Dasara, Diwali, and Kannada Rajyotsava.



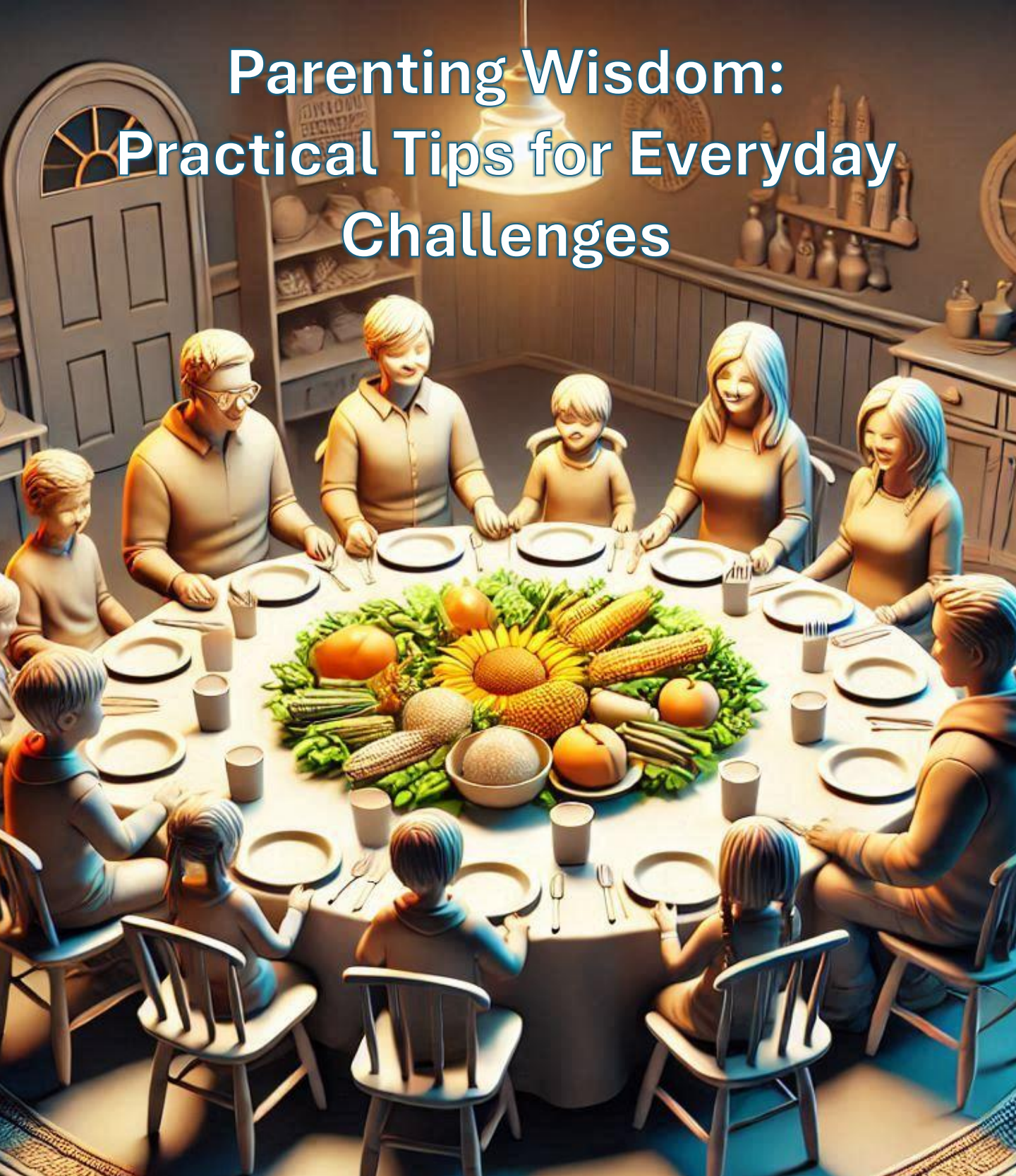
**Practice 'n' Perform:** Gross Motor Skills- Yoga, Aerobics, structured games act like vehicles, climbing stairs using alternate feet, kangaroo jump, passing the ball, hopping on one foot, walking zig zag, balancing ball between knees, catch and throw ball, walking backward.

**Fine Motor skills :** Stringing beads, sorting balls, puzzles, stacking cups, newspaper rolling/folding, cut and paste, palm tracing.
